Dear Parent/Guardian,

Following on from previous information regarding the supervised asymptomatic testing of pupils on their return to school in January, please find below arrangements regarding these days. Please note, if you have consented for your child to have the flu vaccination, the immunisation team will also be in school on the same days to administer the flu vaccination.

#### Monday 10th January

- All of years 8,9 and 10 will have their supervised test and flu vaccination if you have consented.
- No lessons will be taking place in school for any year group all pupils should access online learning on Firefly.
- Pupils in years 8, 9 and 10 should enter the school through the **WEST ROAD** entrance and report to the Sports Hall.

#### Tuesday 11th January

- All of years 7 and 11 will have their supervised test and flu vaccination if you have consented.
- All of years 8,9 and 10 will be in school for their normal lessons.
- No lessons will be taking place for years 7 and 11 in school pupils should access online learning on Firefly.
- Pupils in years 7 and 11 should enter the school through the **PARK ROAD** entrance and report to the Sports Hall. There will be no access available through West Road.

All pupils need to be in **full school uniform** when they come for their supervised test/vaccination. Testing/vaccination times for each form group are below, pupils need to arrive at their allotted time:

We anticipate that pupils will have had their test/vaccination and be leaving the school premises by the start time of the session that follows theirs.

If you are going to be dropping off and collecting your child please be aware that the school car parks will all be closed and it may get congested at the bottom of Park Road if there are a large proportion of families doing this. Can we also inform you that due to safeguarding, no parents will be allowed on the school site with pupils.

## **Reporting of results**

Please note that you will only be notified if your child tests positive for Covid-19 on their supervised lateral flow test. Notifications will not be sent for negative test results.

#### Consent

If you have already given consent for your child to have supervised asymptomatic testing in schools previously then you do not need to give consent again. However, if you did not give consent for your child to be tested last time and you would like to now, please could you complete the consent form. Likewise, if you wish to withdraw consent you will also need to update your preferences by filling out the consent form again.

### **Flu Vaccination**

Consent for the flu vaccination has to be given to the Derby City Immunisation team. If you haven't already given consent and would like to, the consent form can be found on the school website under the 'Latest news and forms' tab on the right hand side.

Please note – pupils will only be given the flu vaccination if the immunisation team have consent from you.

If your child is having just a Covid test or just the flu vaccination, they still need to arrive at the time stated above.
