Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for supporting your children so expertly through these unprecedented times. This support has enabled pupils to complete this academic year while overcoming the hurdles of lock downs, remote learning, periods of isolation and adapting to a hub timetable.

Plans for September are well on the way and we wanted to communicate with you regarding the school's code of compulsory dress.

You will be already aware that West Park School has very high expectations of its pupils. This is to help them achieve their full academic potential and to develop the skills and qualities to be successful post 16. These high expectations include pupils adhering to the school's code of compulsory dress.

We are not a school that demands pupils wear a specific uniform from certain suppliers. We have always avoided this to keep the cost of uniform as low as possible for our families. However, there are certain standards that must be adhered to. These are all outlined in the code of compulsory dress which is below:

#### **CODE OF COMPULSORY SCHOOL DRESS**

## Colours of School Dress - Black and White All items of uniform and kit need to be clearly labelled and all pupils require a decent sized ruck sack.

School Skirt Style - Davenport 913585A/Charleston LA1401/Trutex Blue Max or similar
Black or white short-sleeved polo shirt Black V-neck sweater or sweatshirt Black non-canvas shoes

Coats – plain dark colours, no hoodies (with or without zips), no denim, and no gilets/body warmers.

The addition of a 'high-viz' tabard and arm bands are recommended for the winter – these can be purchased from School Finance Office.

#### We take a very strong line on the following:

- Jewellery, nose studs, eyebrow bars/rings and tongue studs MUST NOT be worn.
- A pair of modest sized ear studs is acceptable (one stud per ear). Body piercing is NOT allowed on the grounds of health and safety.
- Excessive or badly applied make-up MUST NOT be worn.
- Nail varnish, Acrylic or false nails MUST NOT be worn.
- No extreme hairstyles in colour, cut or arrangement. No eyelash extensions and no eyebrow alterations.
- No jeans, combat trousers or tracksuit bottoms.
- Black 'jean style' skinny trousers, black skinny trousers or black leggings are not
- acceptable as school uniform.
- Skirts must be a tailored, pleated or match the style Davenport 913585A/Charleston LA1401/Trutex Blue Max or similar. Tube style skirts or Jersey material are not allowed.

In September all pupils' uniform will be checked to ensure it adheres to the school's code of compulsory dress. Parents will be contacted if there are any issues.

When shopping for uniform please ensure the code of dress outlined above is adhered to. Shops will have numerous items advertised as school uniform. A lot of these items will not be suitable for West Park School e.g. black leggings, tube skirts, black trainers etc. If you need any clarification on this please do not hesitate to get in touch.

Also, included in the next four pages of this letter are schools PE kit expectations.

Please use the summer break to have a conversation with your child and check their uniform is suitable for their return September.

Thank you for your continued support. We are looking forward to welcoming back our brilliant pupils in September.

• Navy blue reversible rugby top or navy blue, plain sweatshirt.







- Navy blue football socks (white sports socks summer term).
- Football boots if on the fields, trainers if on the playgrounds or astro-turf area. (Trainers only summer term).



#### Colder Weather Additions for Outdoor Activities

#### October-Easter:

• Sports leggings that are plain black or plain navy blue can be worn but underneath shorts only.



• Alternatively, plain black or plain navy blue tapered tracksuit bottoms can be worn except in rugby where sports leggings are permitted.







Loose/baggy fitting bottoms are not permitted.

- Additional tops (not school polo shirts) can be worn underneath reversible rugby tops/navy blue sweatshirts.
- Black or navy blue gloves can be worn for activities such as fitness and football (not rugby or netball).
